

PACKAGING SORTING INSTRUCTIONS



CARDBOARD AND PAPER

SUITABLE

- Paper or cardboard packaging
- Cardboard boxes
- Newspapers, magazines, books (to a small extent)

NOT SUITABLE

- Dirty and watered cardboard and paper
- Paper containing other material (e.g. foil)
- Used paper dishes
- Ice cream and candy wrappers



METAL AND PLASTIC

SUITABLE

METAL

- Beverage cans of aluminum and other metal
- Metal lids and caps
- Clean cans

PLASTIC

- Plastic drink bottles
- Windscreen washer fluid canisters
- Clean yogurt cups
- Clean oil, ketchup and mayonnaise bottles
- Clean shampoo bottles and cosmetic packages
- Clean plastic boxes (e.g. salad boxes)
- Clean and empty plastic bags
- Empty and clean tetrapacks (e.g. milk and juice packs)
- Film

NOT SUITABLE

- Plastic toys
- Rubber products
- Used diapers
- Dirty and half-filled tetrapacks
- Packaging of hazardous substances (e.g. glue, paint and solvent packaging)



GLASS

SUITABLE

- Glass bottles and jars
- Other clean glass containers

NOT SUITABLE

- Window and sheet glass
- Light bulbs and energy saving lamps
- Mirror glass
- Packaging of hazardous substances (e.g. solvent bottles)
- Glass and ceramic dishes and pots

REMINDER

- Use transparent plastic bags to collect packages.
- Please make sure the packages are empty and clean. If necessary, rinse with a little water.
- Household or organic waste is not suitable for the packaging container.
- Press the packages together, so it fits more.
- Remove caps and lids from glass bottles and place them in plastic and metal container.
